As a member of Cambridgeshire Nomads Hockey Club you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager. For the personal safety of outfield players, the club recommends the use of shinpads and mouthguard. Goalkeepers will not be allowed to take part in a session unless they are wearing full kit.
- All players must notify their captain/coach if they are carrying or have sustained an injury prior to taking part in any game/training.
- Members must pay subscriptions and match fees promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
